



How to Apply

A J-1 visa is required to attend the University's Study Abroad America Program. It is easy to apply. Simply follow these steps to receive a DS-2019:

- 1. Complete an online **Application Form** at www.csudh.edu/alcp/apply-alcp.
- 2. **Application Fee** \$100.00 U.S. (non-refundable): Payment Options:
 - A) check or money order payable to CSUDH; or
 - B) credit card
- 3. **Financial Verification** Send original bank statement in your name, an original bank statement and a signed affidavit support form if someone else is sponsoring your studies or proof of scholarship. These statements must show a minimum balance of \$11,750 U.S. dollars for one semester or \$25,000 U.S. dollars for an academic year.

- 5. Send an unofficial copy of your current transcript.
