
By studying at Tamwood Careers, you can apply for admission with advanced standing to one of our academic pathway partners. Under the block course transfer agreements that Tamwood has with several Canadian public colleges and universities, you can transfer some or all of the courses you took at Tamwood Careers to the partner institution thus saving you tuition fees and study time at the partner institution. On completion of your program at the pathway partner college/ university, you will be eligible for a Post-Grad Work Permit.

FIELD TRIPS

WORK PRACTICUM, INTERNSHIP AND PART-TIME WORK

CO-OP WORK PLACEMENT

The Diploma programs in Hospitality and Tourism, Food and Beverage, and Business include a Co-Operative paid work term placement of 480 hours, which prepares you for a career in your chosen field. Co-Op positions are typically entry level to get you working from the ground up. These paid work placements are available in: Vancouver, Whistler, Toronto and other areas in British Columbia, Alberta and Ontario.

WORK PRACTICUM/INTERNSHIP

The Innovation and Entrepreneurship (Practicum) Diploma includes an unpaid practicum placement of 160 hours, which allows you to get firsthand professional experience in Canada in a startup or early stage business. The work experience emphasizes the practical application of the learned theory, methods, skills, professionalism, orientation and ethics in a work setting.

OPTIONS FOR CANADIAN IMMIGRATION OPEN TO TAMWOOD CAREERS STUDENTS

Canada is actively seeking more immigrants and has a number of immigration programs designed to attract specific groups of immigrants including internationals who have Canadian education and work experience, foreign skilled workers and entrepreneurs.

CANADA'S STARTUP VISA PROGRAM

Canada's Startup Visa Program targets immigrant entrepreneurs with the skills and potential to build businesses in Canada.

Students in the Global Startup School @Tamwood Careers develop a business idea as well as the skills, entrepreneurial mindset, Canadian business connections and financing opportunities necessary to turn their idea into a successful business in Canada. Tamwood Careers supports students, through its training, mentoring and introductions to Recognized Incubators in Canada, to qualify for the Canadian Startup Visa. You don't need to have a business idea to get started. Ask us about how we can help you (and your family) immigrate through this program.

EXPRESS ENTRY PROGRAM: CANADIAN EXPERIENCE CLASS

Internationals with good language skills in English and/or French, Canadian work experience and Canadian education may qualify for immigration under this program.

Canadian Experience Class Pathway for Tamwood Students

- Students can study IELTS preparation with Tamwood Language Centres to prepare for the IELTS exam.
- 2. Students can transfer the courses they took at Tamwood Careers into one of Tamwood Careers' partner public colleges to qualify for a one year Post-Graduate Work Permit and get their Canadian work experience.
- **3.** Students earn extra points for having a Diploma from Tamwood Careers.

EXPRESS ENTRY PROGRAM: Foreign skilled worker

This program is for skilled workers with foreign work experience who want to immigrate to Canada permanently. There are minimum requirements for education, language ability and skilled work experience.

International students with prior work experience can earn more points to qualify for this immigration program by studying with Tamwood:

- 1. Study English at Tamwood to obtain points for language skills maximum points 28
- Study in a certificate or diploma program at Tamwood Careers to get points for education – 15 points for a Tamwood Careers Diploma
- Turn your Co-Op work experience into an arranged job offer after graduation and earn an extra 10 points for having an arranged job

UNIVERSITY TRANSFER PROGRAM

Tamwood Careers students who want to further their Canadian education at a Canadian public college or university have the option to apply to one of our pathway partners for admission with advanced standing. Tamwood has entered into articulation agreements with several public institutions and a private university in Canada that allow for a block transfer of courses from Tamwood Careers to the public institution/private university.

Why start your Post Secondary Education Program at Tamwood Careers:

- 1. Flexible start dates: most of our programs offer monthly intakes so you don't have to wait for the next available start date at a public college or private university to start studying in Canada.
- 2. Small classes: classes at Tamwood are small, with a maximum of 30 students, so you can begin your studies in Canada in a supportive and personal environment.
- **3. Flexible study locations:** Tamwood has campuses in Toronto, Whistler and Vancouver so you can start your program at Tamwood Careers in any one of these cities and later move to another Canadian location to attend a public college or university to complete your program.
- 4. Save money: Tamwood Careers' tuition fees are less expensive than most public colleges and universities so you can save money by completing some of your courses towards your degree or public college diploma at Tamwood Careers.

- 5. Obtain two credentials: by starting your program at Tamwood Careers and then transferring into a public college or university you will finish with two credentials: a certificate or diploma from Tamwood Careers and a diploma or degree from one of our pathway partner institutions.
- 6. Become eligible for a post graduation work permit: students who articulate from Tamwood Careers into a public college or university and complete their studies on a full-time basis are eligible for a post-graduate work permit which allows them to stay and work in Canada for up to three years post graduation.
- 7. Gain admission with a lower English level: Tamwood Careers has a lower admission requirement with respect to English language skills than its pathway partners so you can start studying in your preferred program at Tamwood Careers and upgrade your English skills while studying at Tamwood Careers through an English program at Tamwood Language Centres.

ENGLISH PREPARATION FOR UNIVERSITY

Students who want to transfer their Tamwood Careers courses into a program at a Canadian University or public college can take the English for Academic Purposes Program offered by Tamwood Language Centres during their Tamwood Careers program to ensure they meet the English language requirements for admission to one of our pathway partner universities / public colleges.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age: 19 years.
- Minimum one academic year post-secondary studies or 24 months of work experience in any field.
- Language Skills: You must demonstrate High Intermediate level English with Tamwood Careers' online test and admission interview. The online test and interview are exempt if CEFR B2, IELTS 5.5, TOEFL ibT 46-59, Cambridge FCE (C), Tamwood Language Centres' High Intermediate level or EAP 192 is presented.

You don't need to have a business idea or team fleshed out before you apply. You will develop both in the program!

Note: These minimum requirements cannot be waived by either the institution or the student.

VISAS

STUDY PERMIT

All international students require a valid Study Permit issued by IRCC to attend classes. To apply for a study permit you will need:

- **1.** A Letter of Acceptance from Tamwood Careers with our DLI number
- 2. A Valid Passport
- **3**. Proof that you can financially support yourself, and any family that come with you, while you are studying in Canada
- 4. A medical exam, if required
- 5. Biometrics

Please visit the Canadian Citizenship and Immigration website to learn more about eligibility and application procedures.

OFF-CAMPUS WORK RIGHTS

Your study permit will state that you are eligible to work off-campus for up to 20 hours a week during your study terms and full-time while you are on your study term breaks.

WORK PERMIT

For programs that include a Co-Operative work term or work practicum, international students are required to obtain a work permit as well as a study permit. You can apply for the work permit on the study permit application. You must indicate on your study permit application that work is a necessary part of your program and submit a letter from Tamwood Careers confirming this. You cannot start your Co-Op work term until you have presented your valid work permit.

- Evidence of prior post-secondary studies or two years work experience (GSS students only).



If you are accepted into the Program we will send you an invoice for the application fee and tuition deposit and on receipt of your payment, send you the Letter of Acceptance for your program.



Apply for your Canadian Study Permit and Work Permit if applicable.

*For Toronto students only. If a student completes his or her secondary or post secondary education outside of Canada or the USA, the student must pass a FREE test (Wonderlic) to be accepted for the program.
