COURSES

A-levels at Kings

A-levels at Kings are defined by a highly intensive, highly personalised structure to ensure effective and efficient learning.

Ultra small classes combine with a supportive, friendly college environment to ensure individual progress is maximised.

Key facts

Start dates: September and January

Minimum age: 16

Length:

- 2 Academic years (6 terms)
- Year 12 A-level transfer and one-year retake options available

Lessons: Average 20 – 25 hours per week (plus homework and private study)

Learning outcomes:

- Develop the knowledge and skills that you need to excel at leading universities
- Preparatory programmes are available for students needing English language and/or academic preparation.

Two-year, Year 12 transfer and retakes

We offer the traditional two-year A-level programme with September and January start dates, Year 12 Transfers to Year 13 and one-year retakes subject to students' needs and prior learning.

Exceptionally small class sizes

All A-levels are taught in very small classes to maximise teacher contact and interaction time with students.

Oxbridge and Medical School Preparation

Medical Schools and the world-renowned universities of Oxford and Cambridge are exceptionally competitive. Gaining a place requires equally exceptional credentials.

Several of our staff are Oxbridge alumni and therefore have personal experience of the entry process and entry requirements.

Maximum options

The selection of A-levels is a key issue for our students. Our aim is to provide a range of subjects which offer our students the maximum flexibility for progression to leading universities and degrees. Our academic and university counselling teams liaise closely with admissions tutors to ensure we have a detailed understanding of university entrance requirements and preferred subjects. Our provision is informed by these discussions and has the facilitating subjects, as defined by the Russell Group, at its core.

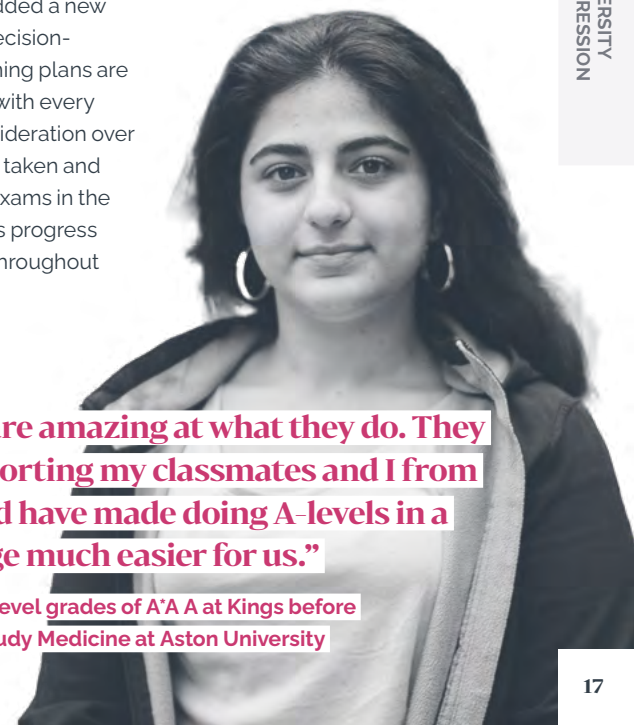
A-level reforms have added a new dimension to A-level decision-making. Individual learning plans are discussed and agreed with every student, including consideration over the number of subjects taken and the value of sitting AS exams in the first year. Each student's progress is carefully monitored throughout their time at Kings.

A-level subjects



Our core curriculum is designed to provide the greatest range of degree progression, centred around subjects which the Russell Group, until recently, referred to as 'facilitating' subjects. They are required by universities and recommended by UCAS as useful for degree entry.

The following subjects are typically taught. We are also able to offer additional subjects, depending on demand and availability. Please contact us to discuss your specific interests.

A-level Art and Design

These courses will develop your intellectual, imaginative, creative and reflective skills. You'll also develop investigative, analytical, experimental, practical, technical, and expressive skills, an aesthetic understanding and critical judgement. You'll gain an understanding of the inter-relationships between art, craft and design, and an awareness of the contexts in which they operate as well as knowledge and understanding of art, craft and design in contemporary society and in other times and cultures.

A-level Biology

Biology is probably the most accessible of the three sciences, as it can be related naturally to all aspects of life. You study carefully, and in detail, how life in the world works: how our bodies work; how diseases stop them working; how plants grow; how life may be threatened by poisonous substances; how ecosystems work; where energy comes from and how organisms use it; how genes and evolution affect us all.

A-level Business Studies

This course introduces core business concepts. You'll develop your understanding of how businesses work, of the current global issues they face and their impact. You'll explore decision-making tools to take a more scientific approach to management.

You'll investigate, analyse and evaluate business opportunities and issues with real-life case studies and use qualitative and quantitative methods to take a more strategic view of decisions and recommendations.

A-level Chemistry

Chemistry is the study of all chemical substances and how they can change. You'll learn to understand these and see in new ways the things that make up the world: your food, fuels and fabrics, building materials and manufactured goods, the air you breathe, the tools you use. You'll study atoms and reactions, bonding and structure, hydrocarbons, polymers and alcohols, energetics and transition elements. You'll use Mathematics to describe and understand chemical ideas. You'll devise and carry out practical experiments to test the principles you are learning.

A-level Economics

The course develops an understanding of economic concepts and theories through a critical consideration of current economic issues, problems and institutions that affect everyday life. It also teaches you to apply economic concepts and theories in a range of contexts and to appreciate their value and limitations in explaining real-world phenomena. You will analyse, explain and evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of the market economy and the role of government within it.

A-level Photography

This course, generally taken alongside A-level Art and Design, allows you to expand your creative horizons through taking and editing photographs. It teaches you about a whole range of photographic techniques and processes and helps you to develop an understanding of the creative process.

A-level Geography

The course will enable you to acquire and apply knowledge and understanding of physical and human processes, their interactions and outcomes over space and time, through the study of places and environments. You'll also develop an understanding of the opportunities, challenges and constraints that people in different places and environments face.

A-level Government and Politics

The course develops a critical awareness of the nature of politics and the relationship between political ideas, institutions and processes. You will acquire knowledge and understanding of the structures of authority and power within the political system of the UK and of other countries. You will also develop knowledge of the characteristics of the legislature, the executive and the judiciary, of the rights and responsibilities of the individual, and of ideologies, theories and traditions.

A-level History

The course develops your use and understanding of historical terms, concepts and skills. The periods studied develop your interest in, and understanding of, important developments allowing you to understand the wider perspective of change and developments over time. You will study significant individuals, societies, events and issues, analysing different historical perspectives, for example aesthetic, cultural, economic, ethnic, political, religious, scientific, social and technological.

A-level Physics

The course will develop your essential knowledge and understanding in physics and, where appropriate, the applications of physics in new and changing situations. You'll develop an understanding of the link between theory and experiment, and will appreciate how physics is used in present

day society. You will recognise the quantitative nature of physics and understand how mathematical expressions relate to physical principles.

A-level Psychology

This course will develop your knowledge and skills across a broad range of topics related to psychology. You will examine cognitive theory as well as different aspects of psychology — developmental, social and biological. You will also develop knowledge of psychopathology as well as practical implementations of psychology and an understanding of research methodology.

A-level Mathematics

The course will develop your understanding of mathematics and mathematical processes and your ability to reason logically and to recognise incorrect reasoning. You will construct mathematical proofs and extend your range of mathematical skills and techniques for use in more difficult unstructured problems. You'll also develop an understanding of coherence and progression in mathematics and of how different areas of mathematics can be connected.

A-level Further Mathematics

A-level Further Mathematics is designed to broaden and deepen the mathematical knowledge and skills developed when studying A-level Mathematics. Studying both A-level Mathematics and A-level Further Mathematics provides you with a foundation for further studies in any science or maths based course, including computer science, medical sciences, psychology, statistics, management and actuarial science.

GCSEs at Kings

GCSEs at Kings offer highly personalised learning and very small classes to ensure maximum student-teacher interaction.

At Kings we offer both a standard two-year and an accelerated one-year GCSE programme with subjects that include Mathematics, English, Art, Biology, Chemistry, Economics, Geography, History, Information Technology and Physics.

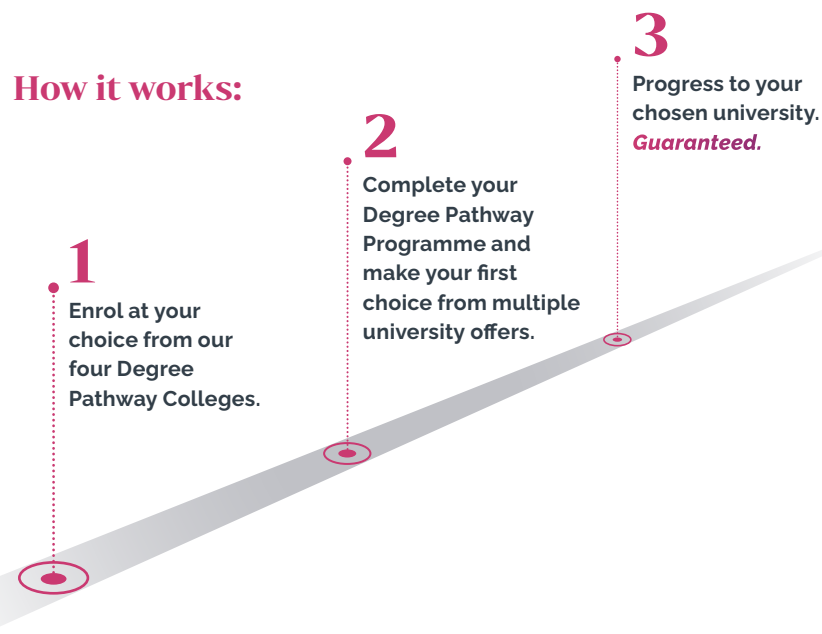

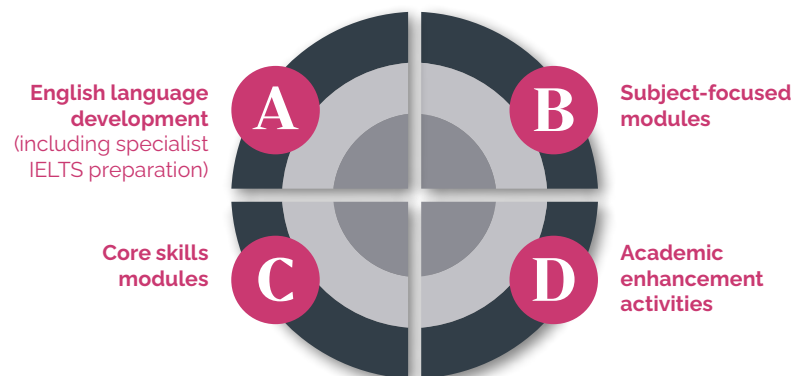

COURSES

Art and Design Foundation

University of the Arts London (UAL) is Europe's largest specialist Art and Design university and is ranked 2nd in the world for Art and Design (QS World University Rankings by Subject 2024).

Kings Schools of Art and Design are Approved Centres to deliver the highly prestigious UAL Level 3 and 4 Foundation Diplomas in Art and Design.

The course is specifically designed to help students gain the knowledge, skills and understanding of creative development and practice required by leading arts universities.

Kings also offers a fast-track pathway combining completion of two Art and Design related A-levels and the Art and Design Foundation.

Key facts

Start dates: September, January (intensive option)

Course length: 1 academic year (3 terms)

Entry requirements: Academic: Completed 11-12 years of schooling,
English: English: IELTS 5.0 or equivalent. Preparatory programmes are available for students needing English language and/or artistic or academic preparation.

Lessons: Average 21 hours per week, plus homework and private study

Minimum age: 16.5

Locations: Kings Schools of Art and Design. These are Approved Centres to deliver this course. They comprise a flagship school in Oxford, and further centres in Brighton and London.

Portfolio requirements

- Applicants are required to submit a portfolio of their work in a PDF or PowerPoint format.
- Work can include good quality photographs of: drawings, paintings, sculptures, short films/ animation, photography and or any other 2D and 3D processes.
- It should show evidence of research and idea development, and a maximum of three different projects and/or a maximum of 10 different pages/slides.
- If the portfolio needs more work, we will recommend applicants take the Kings Art and Design Preparation Programme. This can be 1-3 terms in length and is specifically designed to help students who need to develop their portfolio prior to a main art-related course. It is available to students over the age of 16 in Brighton, London or Oxford.

Course aims

The programme can be taken at Level 3 or Level 4. All students take 3 Units across 3 Terms. Aims of the course include:

- Developing awareness of different creative practices and perspectives
- Researching, analysing, and evaluating relevant information
- Instilling the value of research as an investigative and creative tool
- Exploring solutions to complex problems through practical, theoretical, and technical understanding
- Encouraging independent creative practices and self-led initiatives
- Using critical visual, verbal, and written language to communicate ideas effectively



Students are given the opportunity to explore a specialist area as part of their studies. As they develop, so their work will become focused in the direction they have chosen.

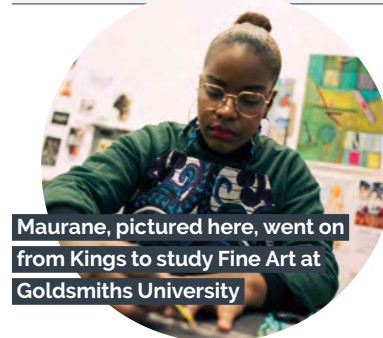
