#### **DIPLOMA | TWO-YEAR**


Combining a strong academic core and stateof-the-art marketplace skills, diplomas lead to careers in the arts, sciences, business, industry, and community services.

### **BACHELOR'S DEGREE | FOUR-YEAR**


Bachelor's degrees require four years of study and are available in Bioinformatics, Business Administration (Accounting, Business Management, Marketing Management) and Recreation Management.

# Pathways to success.



LEAP applicants can receive conditional acceptance to many Langara programs. Successful completion of LEAP 8 leads to direct admission to University Transfer studies at Langara. Your first one or two years of University Transfer courses could also earn you a certificate or diploma from Langara.

#### **UNIVERSITY STUDIES**

Langara's wide range of universitytransferable programs and courses are taught by instructors who are experts in their fields. Gain the credits you need to build a strong foundation to pursue further education or choose your dream career.

You can transfer up to 60 credits to continue your education at one of Canada's top universities or stay at Langara to earn your bachelor's degree while enjoying competitive tuition.

#### **CAREER STUDIES**

These programs are designed with input from industry to meet employer expectations of new graduates. You can be ready to start your career in two years or less with a certificate or diploma program, or complete a bachelor's degree including work-integrated learning options. You can also enhance your skills with post-degree programs to step up your game at work.

This intensive, fast-paced language program prepares students for successful study at English language universities and colleges. Completion of LEAP 8 provides a pathway to admission to a Regular Studies program at Langara.

Some programs provide students the option to alternate full-time study with paid work terms to supplement education costs. International co-operative education (co-op) students must apply for a Co-op Work Permit through Immigration Canada. Eligible international students can work part-time without a work permit.
