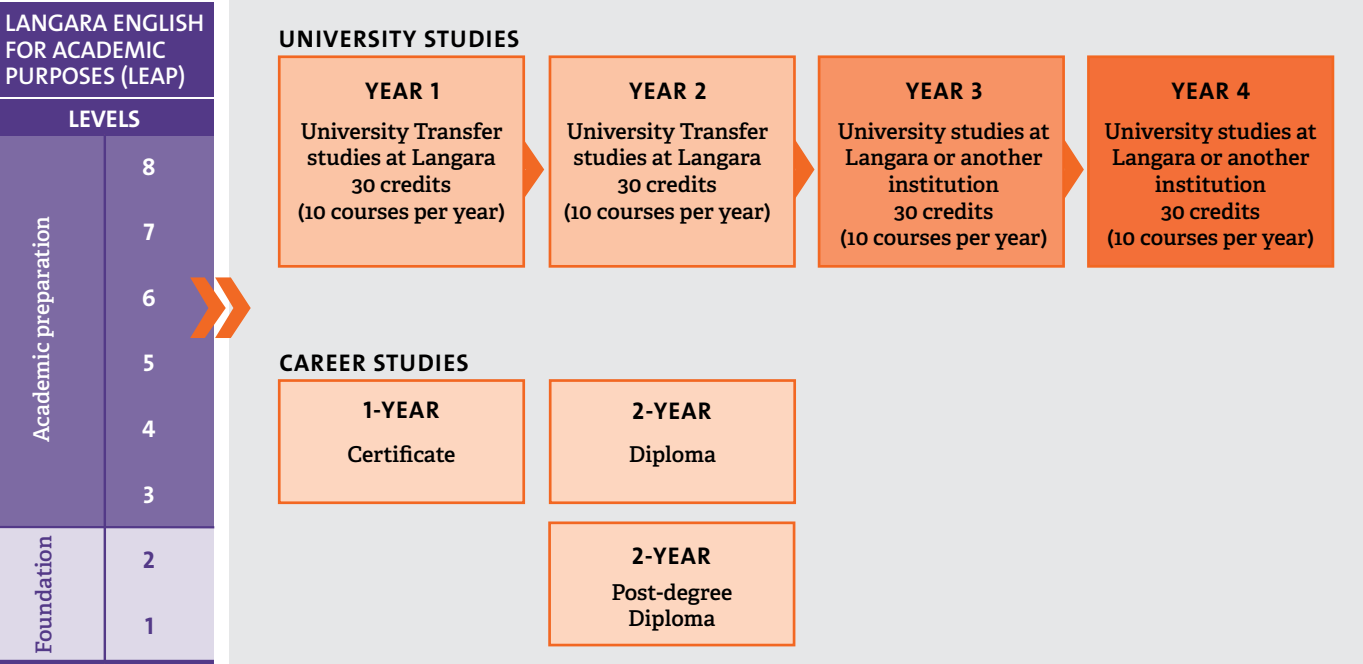

Pathways to success.



LEAP applicants can receive conditional acceptance to many Langara programs. Successful completion of LEAP 8 leads to direct admission to University Transfer studies at Langara.

Your first one or two years of University Transfer courses could also earn you a certificate or diploma from Langara.

UNIVERSITY STUDIES

Langara’s wide range of university-transferable programs and courses are taught by instructors who are experts in their fields. Gain the credits you need to build a strong foundation to pursue further education or choose your dream career.

You can transfer up to 60 credits to continue your education at one of Canada's top universities or stay at Langara to earn your bachelor's degree while enjoying competitive tuition.

CAREER STUDIES

These programs are designed with input from industry to meet employer expectations of new graduates. You can be ready to start your career in two years or less with a certificate or diploma program, or complete a bachelor's degree including work-integrated learning options. You can also enhance your skills with post-degree programs to step up your game at work.

LANGARA ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (LEAP) PROGRAM

This intensive, fast-paced language program prepares students for successful study at English language universities and colleges. Completion of LEAP 8 provides a pathway to admission to a Regular Studies program at Langara.

Program Highlights

- Eight levels of ESL training, from upper-beginner to advanced
- Seven-week sessions
- Six intakes per year
- 20 hours of instruction and learning per week
- Instructors specialize in Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL)
- Students take a placement test to determine their level

Gain work experience.

The work-integrated learning program allows you to gain work experience and make valuable connections in a range of industries. Boost your chances of landing a great job after graduation.

Co-operative education.

Some programs provide students the option to alternate full-time study with paid work terms to supplement education costs. International co-operative education (co-op) students must apply for a Co-op Work Permit through Immigration Canada. Eligible international students can work part-time without a work permit.

The 49th Avenue bus stops at the main campus, while Main Street and Cambie Street buses are only a few blocks away.



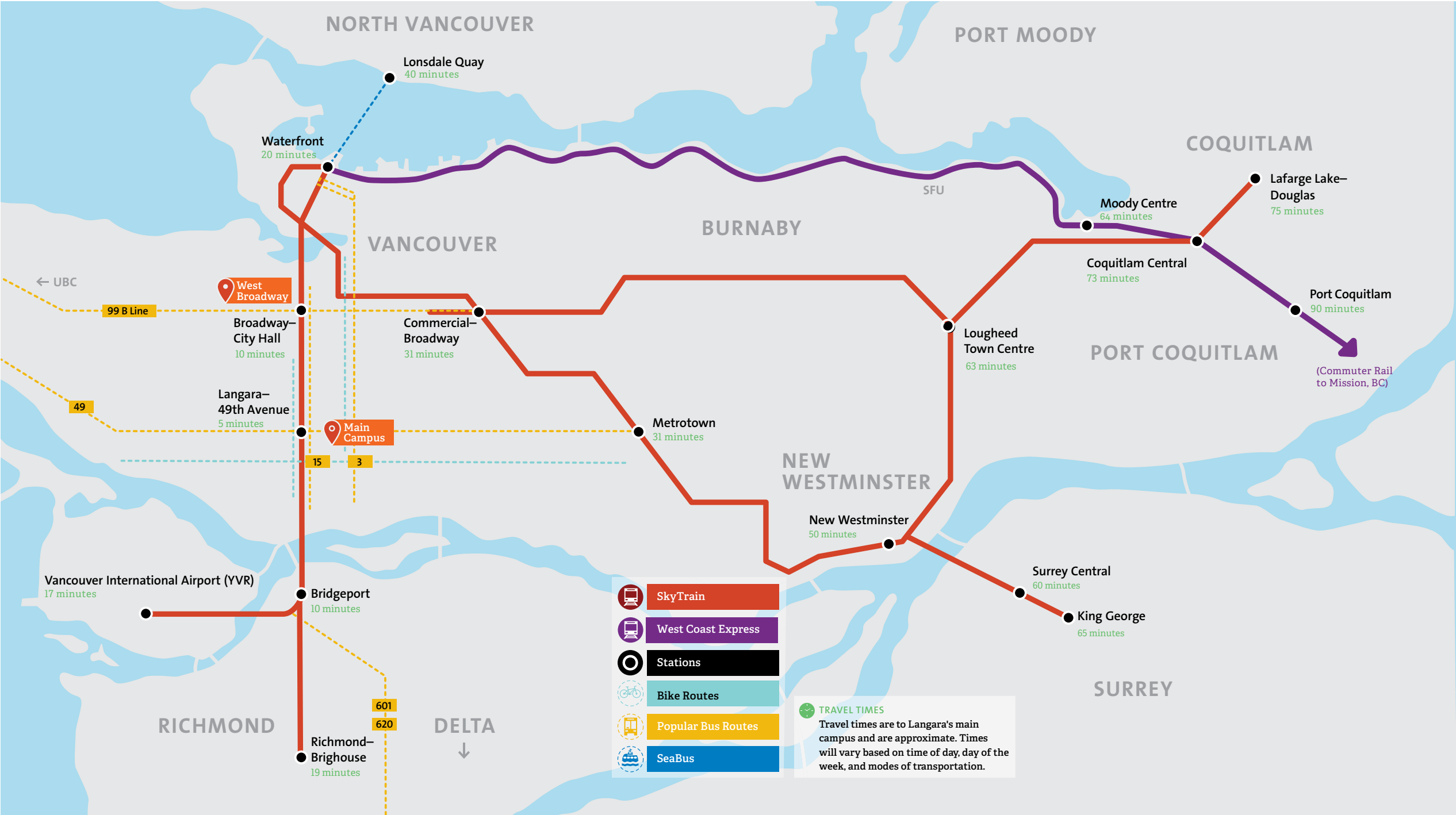
SKYTRAIN
