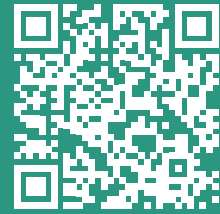

## 2026 TUITION INFORMATION

### Tuition Fees:

Valid for courses starting or extended between **29 December 2025 and 18 December 2026**.

Fees apply only when full payment is made in advance for the entire course duration.

### Course Schedule & Holidays:

There are no classes on weekends or the following UK public/school holidays: *1 Jan, 3 Apr, 6 Apr, 4 May, 25 May, 31 Aug, 25 & 28 Dec*

- › No refunds or discounts for missed classes on these days.
- › No fees are charged for these dates on Platinum Courses or 1-week General English Courses.

### Winter Closure:

All UK centres will be closed **21–28 December 2026** (no tuition fees charged. However, accommodation fees may still apply).

Courses for 2027 begin on Tuesday, 29 December 2026 and are subject to 2027 fees.

### COURSE BREAKS

General English students on longer courses may take short study breaks:

#### › Courses of 9+ weeks:

One-week break (Monday–Friday) allowed after 8 weeks of study.

#### › Courses of 24+ weeks:

One-week break for every 12 weeks of study (max. 2 weeks at a time)

Students must ensure that arrangements comply with their visa conditions, where relevant. Students should select this option and choose dates at the time of enrolment to avoid problems with visas or payment of amendment fees.
