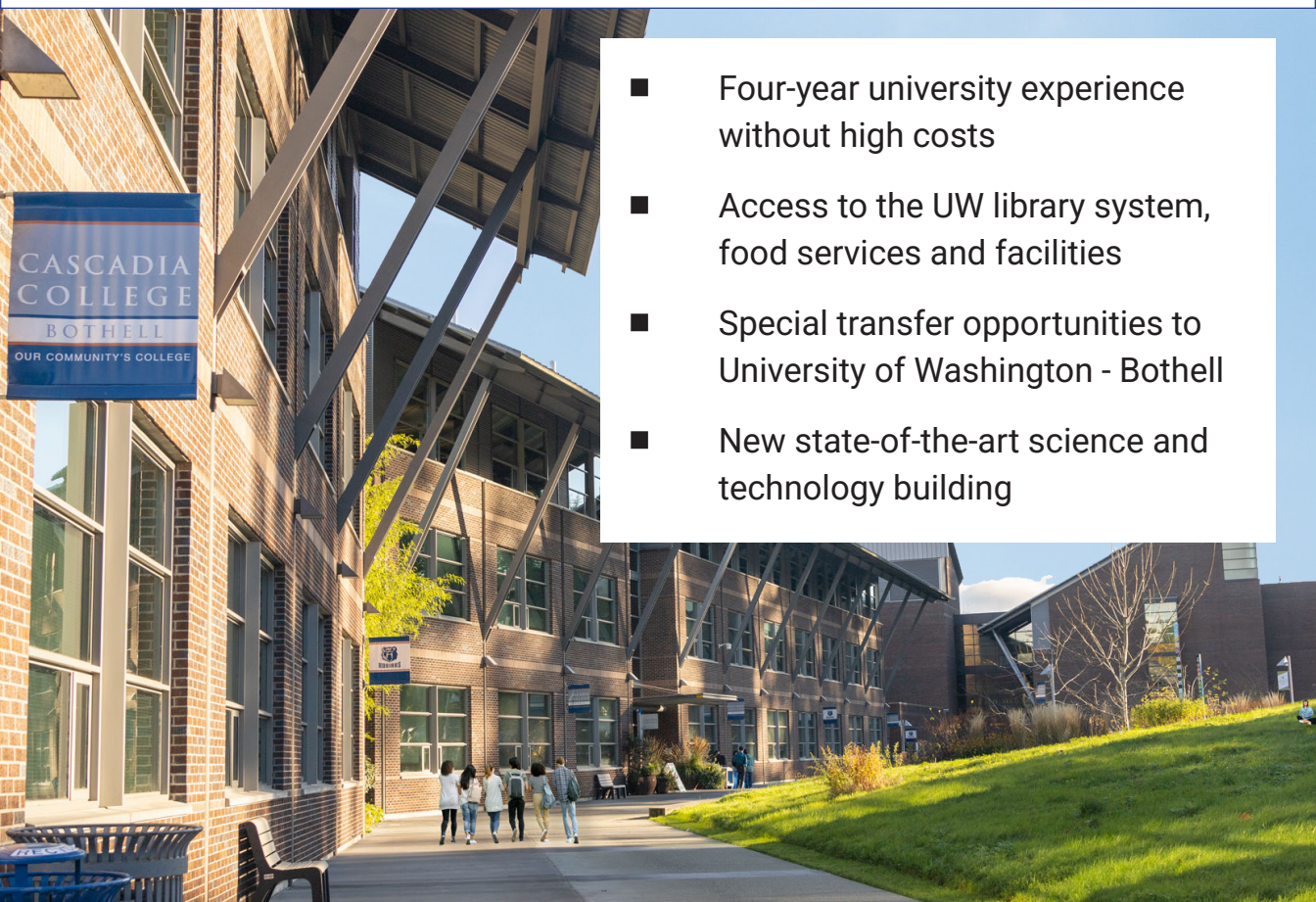
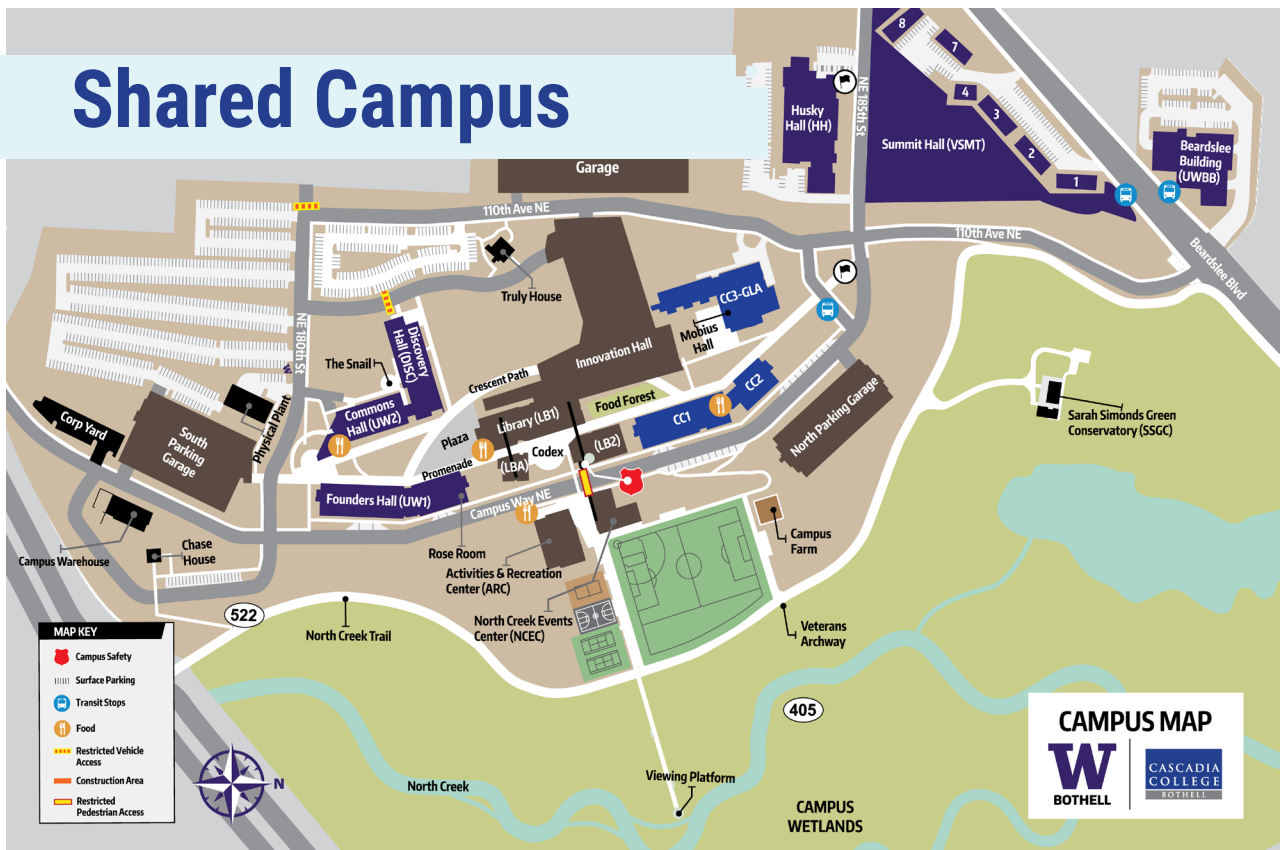

Programs of Study

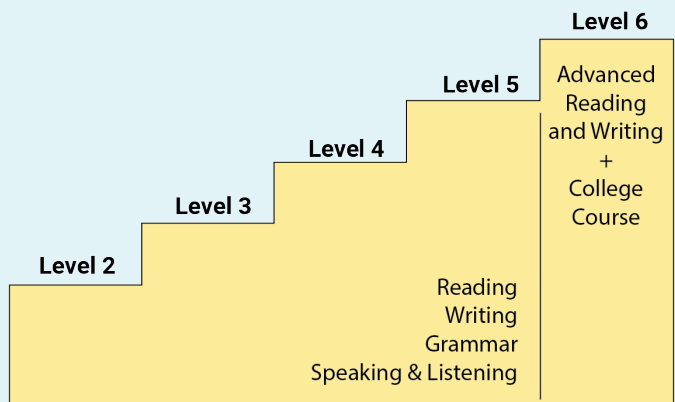
University Transfer

- Study general education courses for 2 years
- Transfer credits earned at Cascadia to your choice of 4-year university to complete your bachelor's degree



English Foundations (EF)

- No English score is required
- Students begin in one of the five levels
- Each level completed in one academic quarter (3 months)
- Students in Level 6 are eligible to enroll in one college course



High School Completion

- Complete coursework to earn credit for high school and college at the same time
- Must be 16 years or older to apply

Application Process



STEP 1: APPLICATION

Complete the online international student application.

STEP 2: BANK STATEMENT

Bank statement should be issued within 3 months, in English, and shows funds for 1 academic year (\$23,463 USD).

STEP 3: PASSPORT

Copy of photo page of your passport in color.

STEP 4: TRANSCRIPT

Copy of most recent high school or college transcript.

STEP 5: ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (OPTIONAL)

English proficiency score is required for placement into the University Transfer Program.

- ▶ TOEFL (iBT): 70 (MyBest™ score is accepted)
- ▶ TOEFL (Essentials): 7.5
- ▶ IELTS: 6.0
- ▶ Pearson PTE 48
- ▶ iTEP 4.0
- ▶ STEP/Eiken Pre-1
- ▶ Duolingo 95 - Production Subscore of 75 or higher
- ▶ SAT 480 ERW Section

STEP 6: SUBMIT

Submit all application documents to the online portal or by email at international@cascadia.edu.

STEP 7: APPLICATION FEE

Pay a non-refundable \$50 application fee to your student account.

STEP 8: WAIT FOR GOOD NEWS!

Completed applications are processed within two business days.
