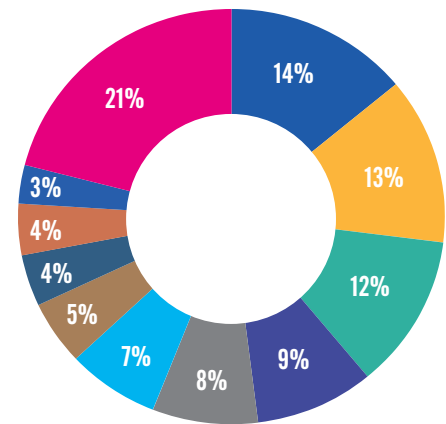
STAFFORD HOUSE CANTERBURY

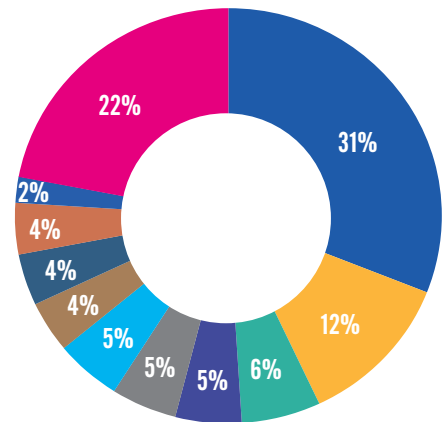

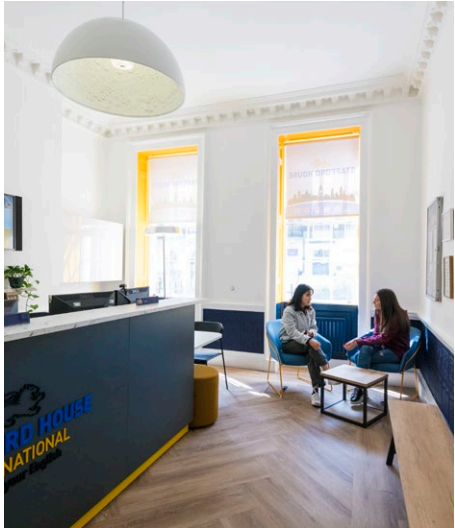

SOCIAL PROGRAMMES

Every week there are a range of exciting social activities taking place across our schools. These help to extend students' English skills beyond the classroom by bridging the gap between the academic and the outside world. To ensure that our social programme is affordable and available to all of our students we have at least 3 FREE activities a week in all our centres.

At Stafford House International we offer lots of different social activities for our students to get involved in. There are a minimum of 3 free activities a week at every Stafford House school. In addition to these free activities, each school runs paid optional weekday activities with prices ranging from between £8-£40 in London, £3.50-£22 in Cambridge and £5-£15 in Canterbury. The weekend excursions have prices ranging from approximately £15-£50 in London, £40-£119 in Cambridge and £15-£45 in Canterbury, making it easy for all of our students to experience a range of trips, explore and socialise no matter their budget.
