History lovers can take a short train to Malahide village for a centuries-old castle and crystal-clear waters. History and Heritage

Dublin's streets are steeped in history. Explore the city's many museums and landmarks, including the grand Central Post Office, which played a pivotal part in the 1916 uprising, and Dublin Castle, a remnant of the city's past. For something a little different, visit the National Leprechaun Museum to learn all about Irish folklore, or brave the dust-covered crypts below St Michan's Church.

Compton Place even has links to royalty: King George III was a frequent visitor in 1780, and Queen Elizabeth II stayed in Compton Place with her sister in 1946.
