Sant a Rosa Junior College is just one hour north of San Francisco. There are more than 256 days of blue skies and sunshine per year in Sant a Rosa, with a July high around 82 degrees Fahrenheit (30 Celsius) and January low around 40 degrees Fahrenheit (4 Celsius). The college's location is widely considered to be one of the best in the entire United States. 

Transfer & Academic Success






