GET STARTED

- 1. Apply online at www.CF.edu/Apply, and select your university transfer program.
- 2. Submit requirements: high school diploma and transcript evaluation, TOEFL 61, IELTS 5.5 (accepted, not required), passport and Financial declaration of \$20,663 USD (Annual tuition: \$10,517 USD).
- 3. Meet the deadlines: July 1 (Fall), November 15 (Spring), April 1 (Summer).
