
Seattle, Washington

The area is headquarters for worldclass companies such as Starbucks, Microsoft, T-Mobile, Costco, and Amazon.








Shared Campus

- Transfer credits earned at Cascadia to your choice of 4-year university to complete your bachelor's degree

STEP 1: APPLICATION

Complete the online international student application.

STEP 2: BANK STATEMENT

Bank statement should be issued within 3 months, in English, and shows funds for 1 academic year (\$21,177 USD).

STEP 3: PASSPORT

Copy of photo page of your passport in color.

STEP 4: TRANSCRIPT

Copy of most recent high school or college transcript.

STEP 5: ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (OPTIONAL)

English proficiency score is required for placement into the University Transfer Program.

STEP 6: SUBMIT

Submit all application documents to the online portal or by email at international@cascadia.edu.

STEP 7: APPLICATION FEE

Pay a non-refundable \$50 application fee to your student account.

STEP 8: WAIT FOR GOOD NEWS!

Completed applications are processed within two business days.
