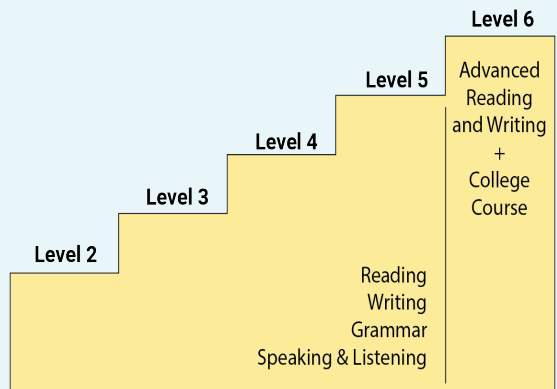




# Programs of Study

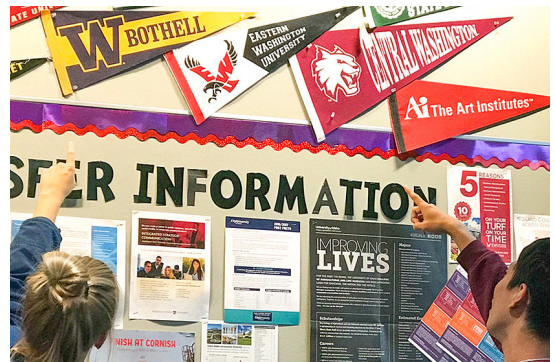
## English Foundations (EF)

- ✓ No English score is required
- ✓ Students begin in one of the five levels
- ✓ Each level completed in one academic quarter (3 months)
- ✓ Students in Level 6 are eligible to enroll in one college course



## University Transfer

- ✓ Study general education courses for 2 years
- ✓ Transfer credits earned at Cascadia to your choice of 4-year university to complete your bachelor's degree



## High School Completion

- ✓ Complete coursework to earn credit for high school and college at the same time
- ✓ Must be 16 years or older to apply

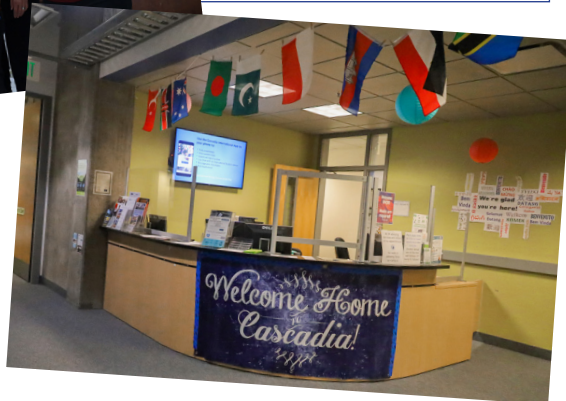

# Application Process



## STEP 1: APPLICATION

Complete the online international student application.

## STEP 2: BANK STATEMENT

Bank statement should be issued within 3 months, in English, and shows funds for 1 academic year (\$21,177 USD).

## STEP 3: PASSPORT

Copy of photo page of your passport in color.

## STEP 4: TRANSCRIPT

Copy of most recent high school or college transcript.

## STEP 5: ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (OPTIONAL)

English proficiency score is required for placement into the University Transfer Program.

- ✓ TOEFL (Essentials): 7.5
- ✓ IELTS: 6.0
- ✓ Pearson PTE 48
- ✓ iTEP 4.0

- ✓ SAT 480 ERW Section

## STEP 6: SUBMIT

Submit all application documents to the online portal or by email at [international@cascadia.edu](mailto:international@cascadia.edu).

## STEP 7: APPLICATION FEE

Pay a non-refundable \$50 application fee to your student account.

## STEP 8: WAIT FOR GOOD NEWS!

Completed applications are processed within two business days.
