Our international college

Located at the heart of the De Montfort University (DMU) campus, our college offers international students an incredible opportunity to study in the UK.

De Montfort University International College (DMUIC) pathway courses allow you to gain subject knowledge, build academic English language skills, and transfer to a DMU degree course upon successfully completing the pathway.

Courses at DMUIC are designed to give you the very best start to your degree with DMU. With experienced teachers and small group sizes, you will receive first-class teaching and the individual guidance needed to adjust to your new life as a UK university student.

Our pathway courses cover a range of undergraduate and postgraduate subjects, including art and design, business and law, engineering, life sciences and pharmacy.

Our online pre-sessional English courses (lasting 6 or 12 weeks) are also available to help you meet our minimum English language requirements.

There are different levels of study offered, such as the International Foundation Certificate (IFC), International Incorporated Bachelors (IIB), and the International Incorporated Master's (IIM).

Within the IIB there are courses known as International Year Zero (IYZ), International Year One (IY1) and International Year Two (IY2). DMUIC will deliver the first stages of the IIB and the IIM before you transition into the next stage of your chosen degree at DMU.

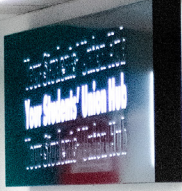

Accommodation

With a range of comfortable and modern rooms close to campus, DMU provides high-quality accommodation perfectly suited to your needs.

If you want to get the most out of your university experience, the right accommodation is hugely important. With nine DMU halls of residence for international students, you have a great choice of places to live either on campus or within 10 minutes' walk. Our flats are mostly en-suite and self-catered with shared kitchens and laundry facilities on site, and there is a choice of mixed or same-gender flats available. If your visa type is "Student visa", you are expected to live within 30 miles of the university

Some halls also offer one or more of the following:

- En-suite bathrooms (all with showers, no baths)
- Deluxe/premium/double bedrooms – pay more for a larger room with more storage and a double bed (single occupancy only)
- Self-contained studio apartments
- Contents insurance
- Common rooms

Rent prices can range from £99 per week for a standard non en-suite room to £191 per week for a studio*.

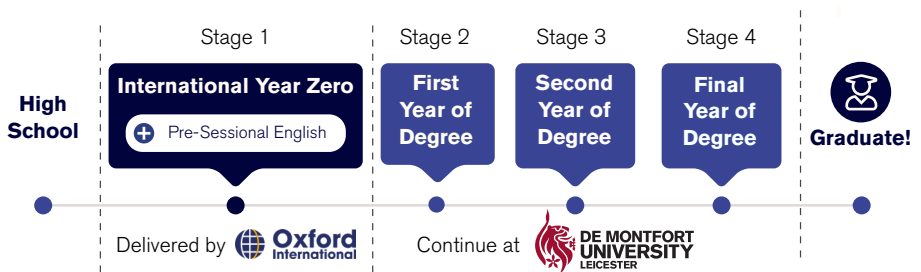
International Foundation Certificate

The International Foundation Certificate (IFC), a one year stand alone course, is designed to help you gain extra English language skills and develop your subject knowledge to an undergraduate level.



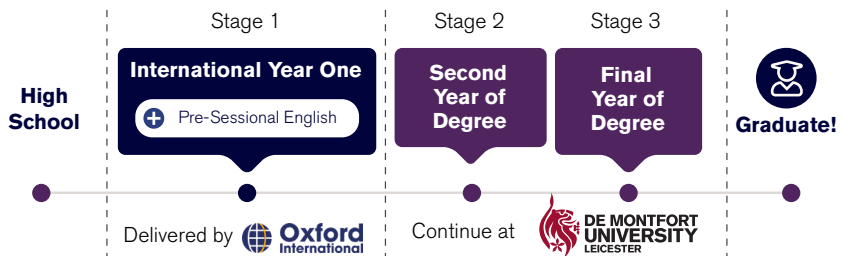
International Year Zero (IYZ)

The IYZ at DMUIC is the first year of a 4-year integrated degree course. IYZ provides 1-year of preparation for entry into the first year of a 3-year Bachelors degree at DMU.



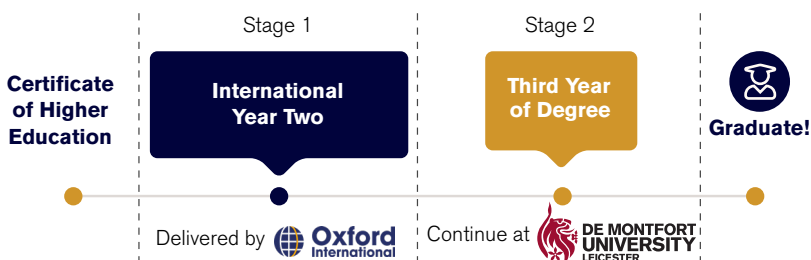
International Year One (IY1)

The IY1 at DMUIC is the first year of a 3-year integrated degree course. IY1 is equivalent to the first year of a 3-year Bachelors degree, leading to direct entry into the second year of a bachelor's degree at DMU.



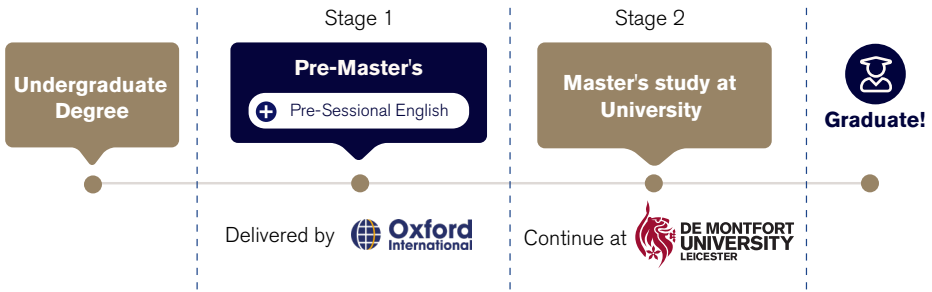
International Year Two (IY2)

The International Year Two (IY2) is equivalent to the second year study of a three-year undergraduate degree. It supports international students who wish to complete their undergraduate studies at DMU.



International Incorporated Master's (IIM)

The IIM provides you with advanced academic and English language skills to continue to postgraduate Master's study. Our course offers either one term (10 weeks) or two terms (20 weeks) of preparation for entry into a range of one-year Master's degrees at De Montfort University.



Pre-Sessional English

Pre-Sessional English is a 6 or 12-week extension course for those who may still need to meet the required English language standards for direct entry to our pathways. See the table below for information on our English language requirements and what pre-sessional course is required:

International Foundation Certificate (IFC)

This course is a pre-university preparatory programme that provides an access route into higher education for international students who need more academic and linguistic qualifications for direct entry into an undergraduate degree programme.

It enables students to enhance their English language capabilities, develop study skills appropriate to the UK Higher Education environment, and study content modules directly related to the undergraduate degree programme onto which they want to progress and acclimatise to living and studying in the UK. It provides an opportunity for international students with at least 11 years of school experience to study for a further year and match home students' educational experiences.

The International Foundation Certificate (IFC) is designed to help you gain extra English Language skills and develop your subject knowledge to an undergraduate level. Depending on your academic profile, you can study a three or four-year degree course. Following successful completion of the IYZ, you will continue onto year one of your degree directly with De Montfort University.

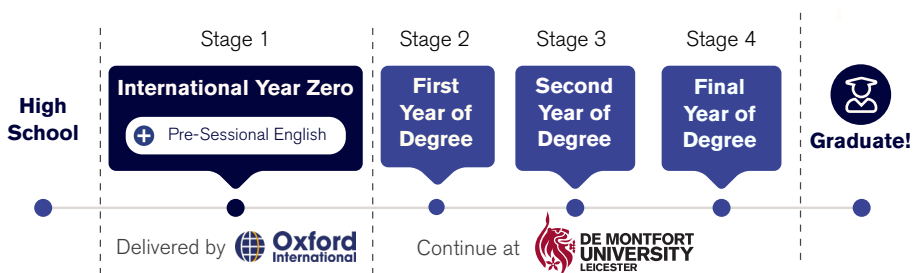

The International Year One (IY1) provides an intensive combination of first year university subject modules with extra study and English language skills. The IY1 is the equivalent to your first year of study at undergraduate level. Upon successful completion, you will continue to the second year of your DMU degree course.

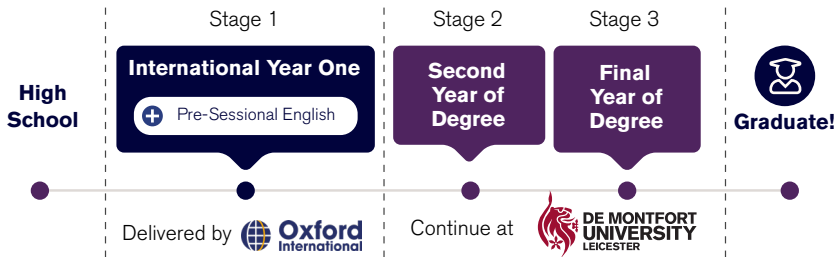

International Year Two (IY2)

The International Year Two (IY2) is equivalent to second-year study of a three-year undergraduate degree. This three-term programme provides an intensive combination of more advanced subject-specific content with the opportunity to develop language and academic study skills as elements of a focused 30-credit module, while studying business management modules, earning the remaining 90 of the 120 second-year credits. Upon successful completion of the ISY, you will continue to the final year of Business Management BA (Hons) at DMU.

The International Second Year (IY2) is equivalent to second year study of a three-year undergraduate degree. It supports international students who wish to complete their undergraduate studies at De Montfort University (DMU) by joining the third year of the Business Management degree.

You can study the IIM over one or two terms depending on your academic qualifications and English language level.

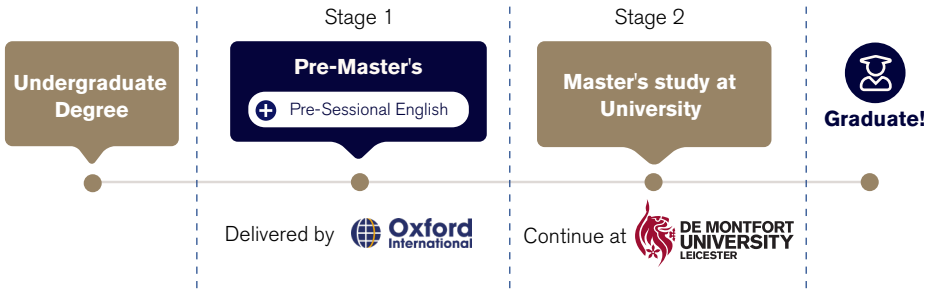

Any current and previous UK visas, CAS letter and copies of exit stamp. Please also include a copy of any previous visa refusal letters



A valid copy of IELTS or Pearson PTE if the score is at 5.5 or above
Only IELTS taken at UKVI-approved centres can be used if the score is below 5.5 in any component.

What will happen after you submit your application?

Stage one: Check qualifications

Stage 9: Pre-arrival

Before the start of the course we will send you details of how to register and a welcome pack.

Stage ten: Welcome to the UK!

Student Visa Route

If your visa type is "student visa", you must live within a commutable distance of our Leicester campus and to engage appropriately with your studies. This distance is 30 miles. The university expects students to be able to readily access academic materials, library services, and professional services support and will expect students to live within a 30-mile radius of the university unless authorised otherwise by their programme supervisor and Immigration Compliance Manager.

Proof of the term-time address must be provided at registration.

For those students who require a student visa to enter the UK, the Home Office requires all student visa sponsors to hold details of a student's current term-time address, including the proximity of their residential term-time address to the sponsor's teaching site. A student visa sponsor must be able to demonstrate that students are engaging appropriately with their studies and within the regulations set out in the Student Visa Policy Guidance.
