

The University of Bradford is made up of four academic faculties with each covering a broad range of specialisms.

Faculty of Engineering and Digital Technologies

Through core engineering disciplines and creative technologies, the Faculty of Engineering and Digital Technologies offers students a wide range of opportunities to discover real-world thinking and application. Opportunities such as industrial placements and internships contribute to our curricula. Courses are aligned to industry needs and our graduates are highly regarded by companies such as Ford, Johnson & Johnson, Jaguar Land Rover, Game Republic and Microsoft.

Faculty of Health Studies

The Faculty of Health Studies works with many partners in health and social care and the voluntary, non-profit and non-government sectors to ensure that our students learn from leading industry professionals. In addition, courses offered are approved by the Health & Care Professions Council (HCPC) and Nursing & Midwifery Council (NMC).

Faculty of Life Sciences

The Faculty of Life Sciences offers students access to state-of-the-art facilities on campus such as the Bioimaging Suite, Anatomage Table and Human Patient Simulator, and a fully equipped Crime Scene House. Your pathway to university

Our pathway programmes at University of Bradford International College will provide you with the English and academic skills you need to succeed at university. Upon successful completion of your programme, you will progress onto your chosen degree course at the University of Bradford*. Our pathway programmes offer you various routes to a degree depending on your level of study, English language ability and subject area.

International Foundation Year (IFY)

The IFY is a Level 3 foundation course that is equivalent to A level qualifications. The course is one year long and during this time, you will gain subject-specific knowledge and enhance your academic English language skills in preparation for university studies.

Subjects offered:

- Business and Management
- Computing and Creative Industries
- Law and Social Sciences
- Science, Engineering and Health

The International Year Zero (IYZ)

The IYZ is the first year of a four-year integrated degree course. Your first year is taught at the college where you will gain extra skills in your subject area, as well as English language, before you continue to year one of your chosen undergraduate degree course.

Subjects offered:

- Business and Management
- Computing and Creative Industries
- Law and Social Sciences
- Science, Engineering and Health

*It is important to note that completing the International Foundation Year programme does not guarantee admission to the University of Bradford. Students who have completed the Foundation Year programme must still meet the entry requirements for their chosen degree course at the university. This may include passing an interview or achieving higher grades.





The International Year One (IY1)

The IY1 is the first year of a three-year undergraduate degree course and equivalent to your first year of study at university.

Subjects offered:

- Business and Management
- Computing and Creative Industries
- Science, Engineering and Health
- Law and Social Sciences

International Incorporated Masters (IIM)

The IIM is offered over one or two terms and provides the advanced academic and English language skills required for entry onto a postgraduate degree course.







After successfully completing the Pre-Masters you will continue onto you chosen post-graduate degree course at the University of Bradford.



To complete your online application, we will need the following:

- A copy of a valid passport
- A copy of your original qualification certificates and transcripts. Certified translations if applicable
- Any current and previous UK visas, CAS and copies of exit stamps. Please also include a copy of any previous visa refusal letters if you previously studied in the UK
- A valid copy of IELTS or Pearson PTE if the score is at 5.5 or above. Only IELTS taken at UKVI approved centres can be used if the score is below 5.5 in any component.
