AVISHIKTA'S EXPERIENCES

Why did you decide to come to Centennial to upgrade your skills?

“I have a bachelor’s degree in Electrical Engineering and worked for Bombardier Aerospace and De Havilland. In 2020, I got laid off due to COVID. I searched for jobs but was unable to find something I wanted to do. So, I decided to upgrade in the aerospace field. I came across this program, which suited my profile and my career path, so I joined.”

What was your favourite part of Aerospace Manufacturing Engineering?

“There are many things this program taught which are industry-related, like CNC, masterCam, Catia software, Solidworks, Ansys and Matlab. Catia is of immense help when it comes to the aerospace industry. My favourite part would be learning Catia and other software.”

What has been your career path since you graduated?

“I joined De Havilland as a Methods Engineer [just weeks after my classes ended]. I’m also planning to join the Reserve Force of the Canadian Armed Forces as an Aerospace Engineering Officer.”

How did the program prepare you for the industry?

“The program is based on industry-specific requirements, which helps one to shine during an interview. It also prepares you for the job you are applying for.”

What do you think students applying to Aerospace Manufacturing Engineering should know?

“To anyone joining this program, I will recommend you try to learn as much as you can. The professors are really knowledgeable and will guide you. Some of them work in good positions in the industry and will be able to recommend you.”

GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

All instruction at Centennial is in English. All applicants must demonstrate an acceptable level of English language proficiency to be considered for admission.

CO-OP EDUCATION ADMISSIONS

To participate in co-op, register in a full-time co-op-eligible program and complete an application process. If you academically qualify, you may be admitted to the co-op program.

TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

To support your learning, many programs use flexible teaching models, including online, in-person, or a combination of these. Some programs require access to a computing device that meets minimum hardware requirements. Please check the program page on our website for complete specifications.

WAITING LISTS

A program waiting list is created when the number of eligible applicants exceeds the number of available spots in a program. If additional space becomes available, additional offers are sent to the next highest qualified applicants on the waiting list, based on an average of the required subjects.

COMPETITIVE PROGRAMS

For some programs, Centennial receives more qualified applicants than available seats. Minimum admission requirements do not guarantee a seat in these programs, which often have additional selection requirements. If you are applying to a highly competitive program, you must **submit your application before February 1** to be equally considered among all other applicants.

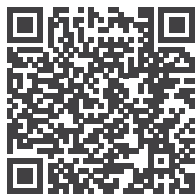

STEP 2

Pay the \$110 fee, which allows you to apply for up to three Centennial programs. November 1 is the earliest date colleges may release offers to applicants. Offers will continue to be issued until programs are filled or wait lists are established.

STEP 3

SEND US YOUR TRANSCRIPTS

- **Current Ontario high school students:** Most secondary school districts electronically send your grades to Ontario College Application Service (OCAS), which sends them to Centennial. We receive interim records after you apply and updated final grades when you successfully complete your studies.
- **Former Ontario high school students and Ontario public college or university students/graduates:** Use the transcript request page in your OCAS application.
- **College or university graduates and graduates from Canadian high schools outside of Ontario:** Visit OCAS for further instructions.
- **Canadian citizens or permanent residents with transcripts from outside of Canada:** Provide a Credential Assessment Report by World Education Services (WES) or International Credential Assessment Service (ICAS). Visit our website for complete details.

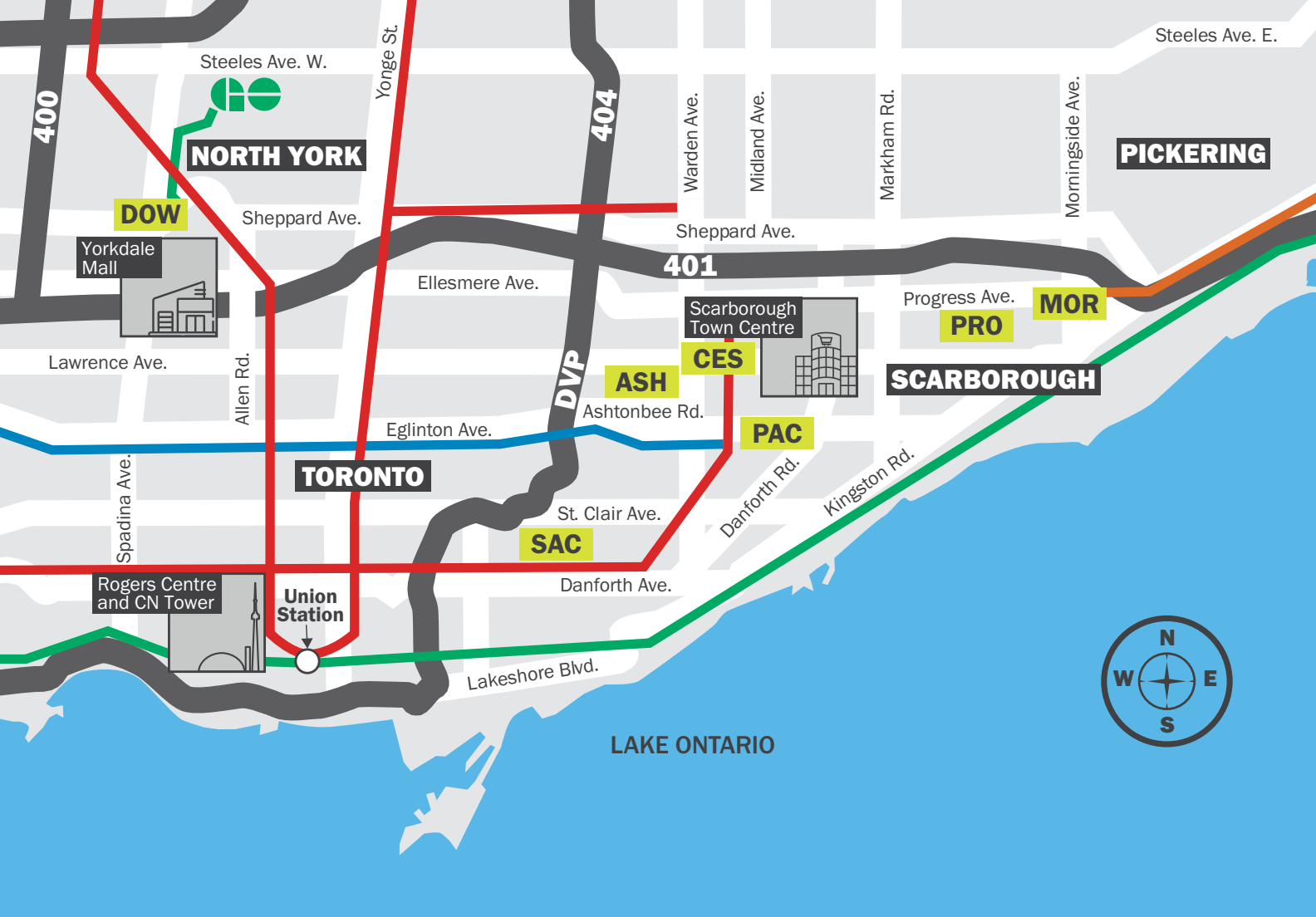
