

Viktoriia earned an Associate's Degree in Economics is currently on OPT (Optional Practical Training), authorizing international students towork for one year in a professional setting related to their major.

International Admission Requirements

- 1. At least 18 years or if underage show proof of high school/secondary school completion
- 2. OCC international student application and \$55.00 application fee
- 3. Proof of English Proficiency for non-native speakers
- 4. Academic transcripts
- 5. Proof of Financial Ability for the first year of study
- 6. Copy of Passport Biographical Page
- 7. Immigration documents for transfer students only (copies of I-20, I-94 card, F-1 visa)
