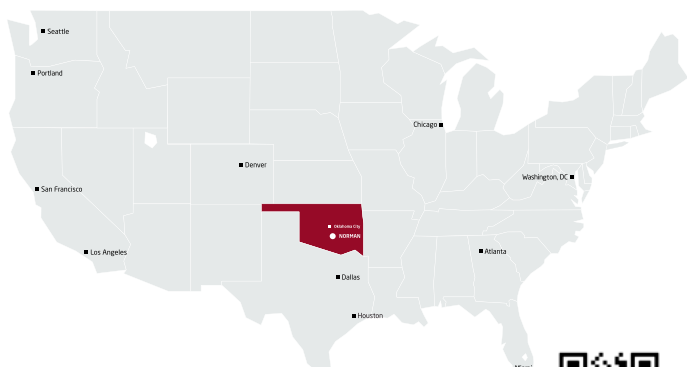

## CAREER STATISTICS

**Students earn a \$60,000 median annual salary** with a bachelor's degree from OU, and benefit from a cost of living lower than most US cities (*University of Oklahoma admissions data 2023*).
