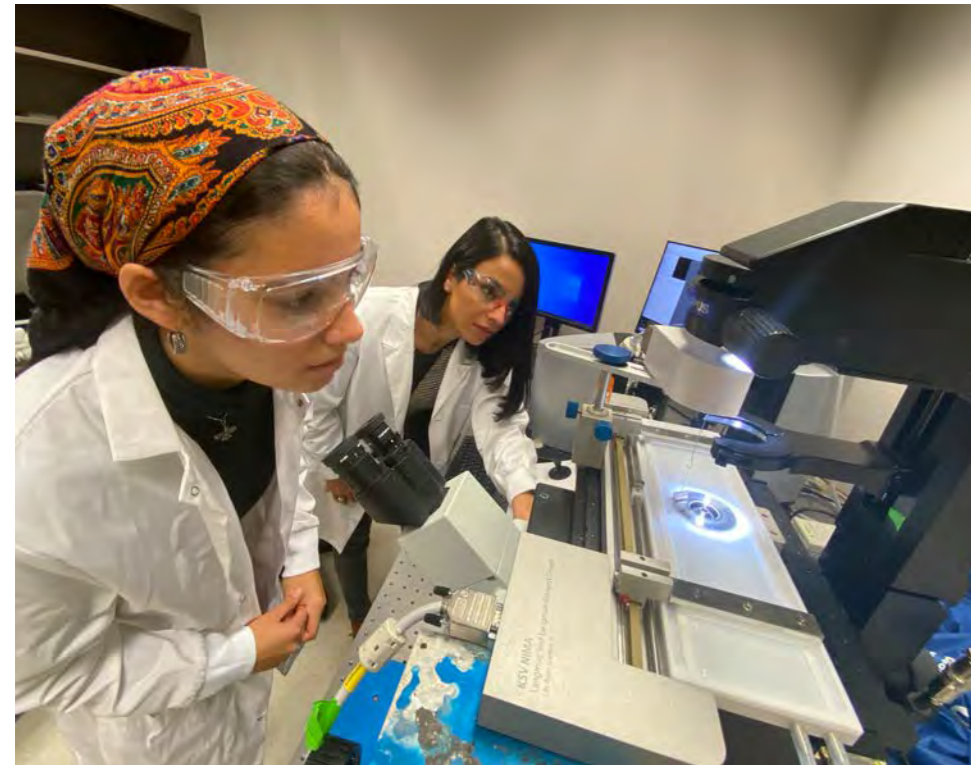
WHY STUDY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA?

THE VALUE OF AN OU DEGREE



- With 74% of graduates accepting jobs within six months of graduation, recent OU bachelor's degree recipients reported an average starting salary close to \$60,000 and enjoy a cost of living lower than most US cities (*Information obtained by OU Career Center from 84.2% reporting 2023-2024 graduates*).
- 96% of Mewbourne College of Earth and Energy graduates were employed six months after graduation (*University of Oklahoma Undergraduate Student Outcomes and Data 2022-2023*).
- According to the *U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics*, the median annual wage for environmental engineers was \$104,170 in May 2024. For petroleum engineers, it was \$141,280 in May 2024.
- According to *Forbes'* 2025 cost of living calculator, the cost of living in Norman, Oklahoma is 53% lower than Los Angeles, California.

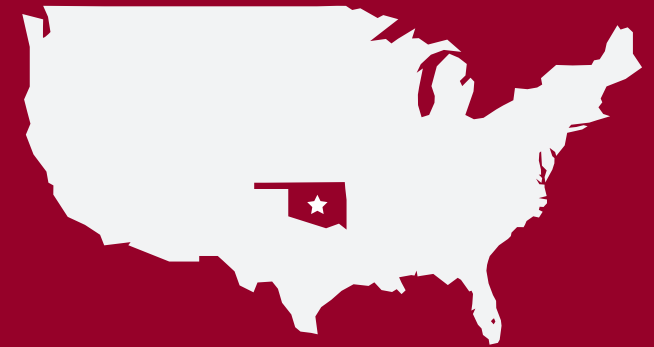
