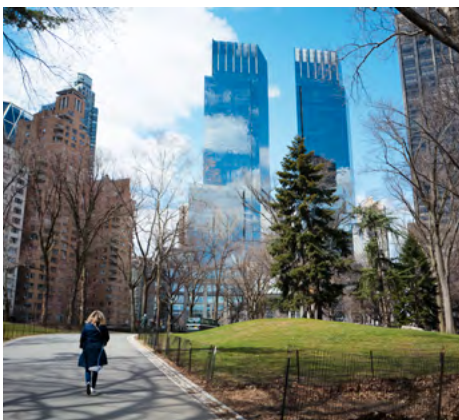
Famous attractions

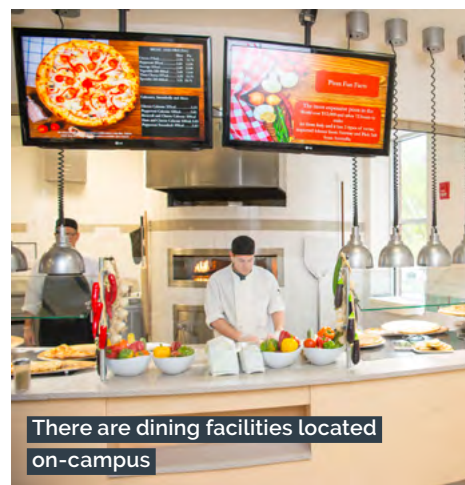

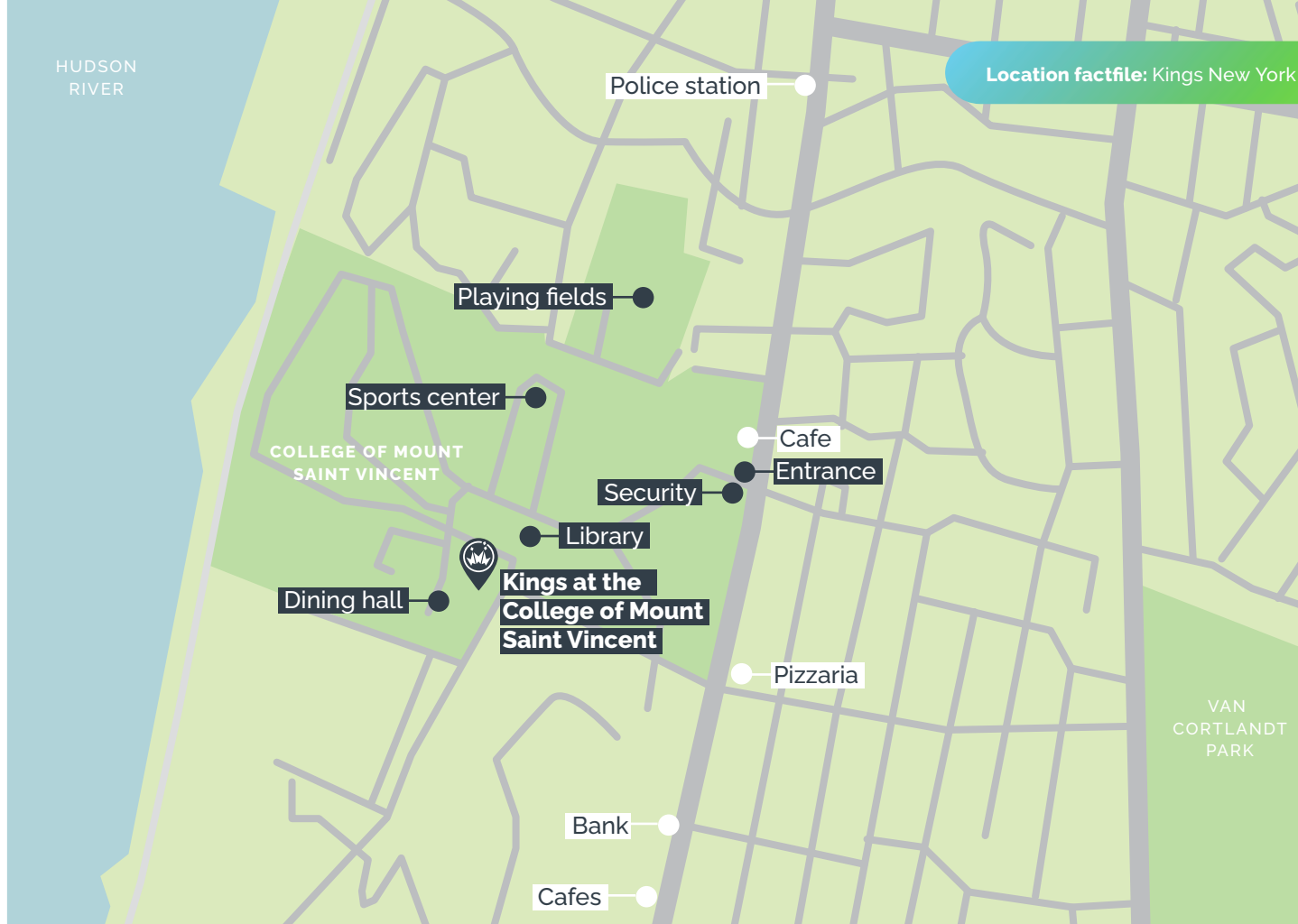

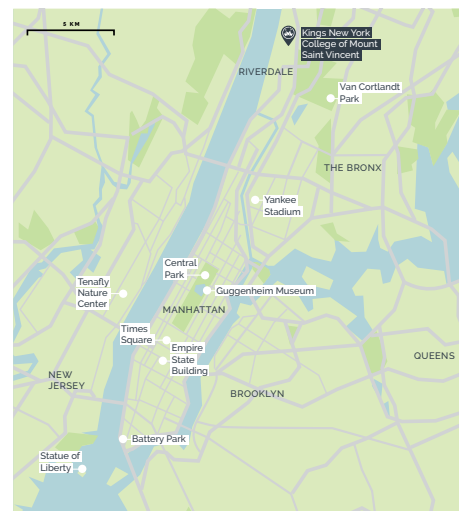

On campus student residence

Kings students will stay in dorm-style residences on the beautiful riverside campus of the University of Mount Saint Vincent, with gorgeous views of the Hudson River.

Students will stay in spacious twin rooms with shared bathrooms. There are separate floors and sections for males and females.

The residence halls are located just 1 to 2 minutes' walk from the main Kings New York office and teaching center in the Founders' Hall building.

Fully-equipped communal kitchens are available in the dorms for students opting for a self-catering meal plan. Meals for half-board students are served at the university's state of the art dining hall, Hudson Heights.



Homestay

Homestay is a great way to experience day-to-day home life in the USA.

We have strong relationships with many local hosts including working families, couples, single people and retired people, who would all like to welcome you into their home.

Our homestays are all very carefully selected and regularly inspected by our experienced Accommodation Officer
