BARISTA ENGLISH PROGRAM

Program Includes

English Classes (Afternoon):

- Improve English communication skills specific to the café and hospitality industry.
- Learn coffee theory — including coffee history, bean types, and brewing methods.
- Explore café vocabulary and customer interaction through role-play and teamwork.

Practical Experience (Hands-on):

- Gain real-world barista experience using commercial espresso machines at the OHC café.
- Practice making popular drinks such as lattes, cappuccinos, and americanos.
- Receive guidance on latte art, beverage presentation, and café workflow.

Career Skills (Professional Focus):

- Learn how to create a café-style résumé and prepare for barista job interviews.
- Understand workplace English used in cafés and hospitality settings.
- Earn the OHC Barista Certificate upon completion of the program.
