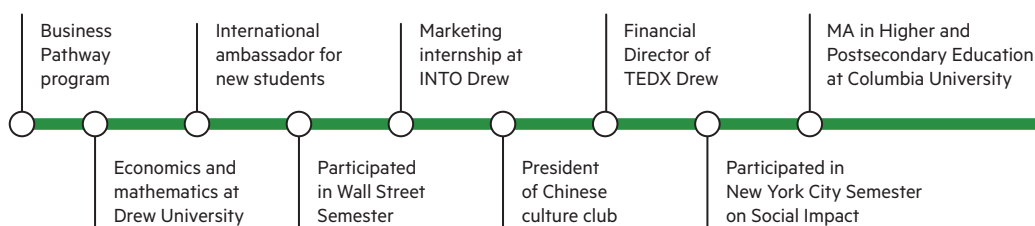

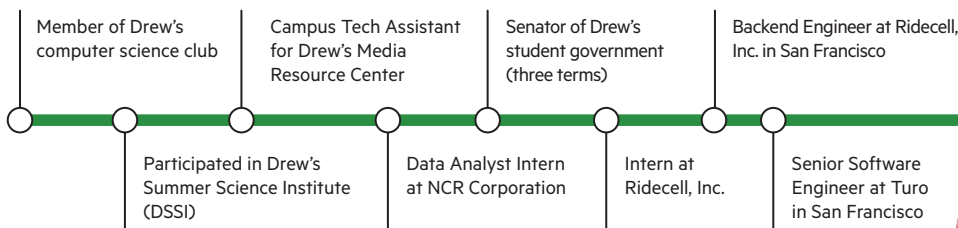

Dual-Degree programs

Drew's Dual-Degree programs put you on the fast track to earning multiple degrees in a variety of fields.

gateway to top universities in the US

In 2024, 14 out of 14 (100%) international students who applied to Columbia and Washington University in St. Louis for the Dual-Degree program were accepted to one or both of the programs for Fall 2024.

In the last eight years, 50+ international students have been admitted to the Dual-Degree program at Columbia University in New York City or Washington University in St. Louis.

Columbia University in New York City

Columbia University is one of the world's most important centers of research and is ranked the No. 13 Best National University by *U.S. News & World Report 2025*. This program leads to a bachelor's from Drew and bachelor's in engineering from Columbia.

Stevens Institute of Technology in Hoboken

Complete a BS in Computer Science or Cybersecurity at Drew and you can apply to earn your MS in Software Engineering at Stevens Institute of Technology.

Washington University in St. Louis

This program leads to a BS from Drew and a BS in Engineering from Washington University in St. Louis, which is ranked the No. 21 Best National University by *U.S. News & World Report 2025*. You will stay for an additional year to earn your master's degree in engineering with guaranteed scholarships.

Finance and Data Science

You can earn a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in finance or data science in only five years. During your undergraduate program, you can dual-enroll in four graduate courses, which will count toward both your major and master's degree, allowing you to save time and money while working toward your advanced degree.

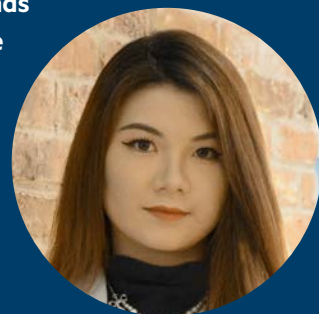

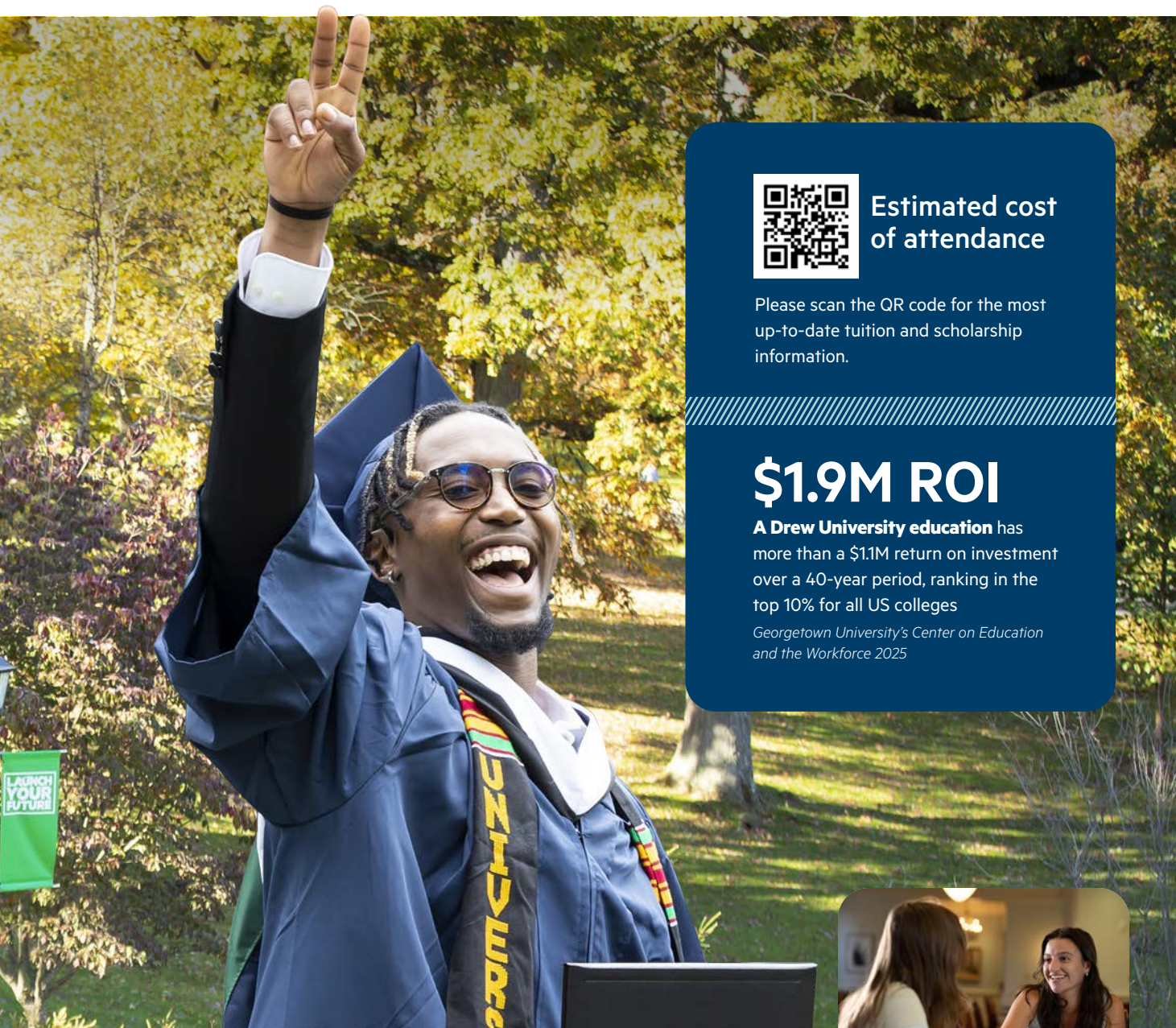

On-campus housing

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING BENEFITS INCLUDE:

- getting to know your peers—85% of the student population lives on campus
- convenient locations close to classrooms, libraries and campus facilities
- a diverse living-learning environment

Eligibility to live off campus may be granted upon successful completion of your Pathway program. On-campus housing is available for graduate students on a first-come, first-serve basis. Housing is available to undergraduate students for all four years. Single rooms may be requested and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Meal plan: All on-campus housing options include a meal plan. Drew has two main dining halls and two cafes for you to enjoy. Students living off campus will have the option to purchase a meal plan when they arrive. Graduate students have the option to not purchase a meal plan.

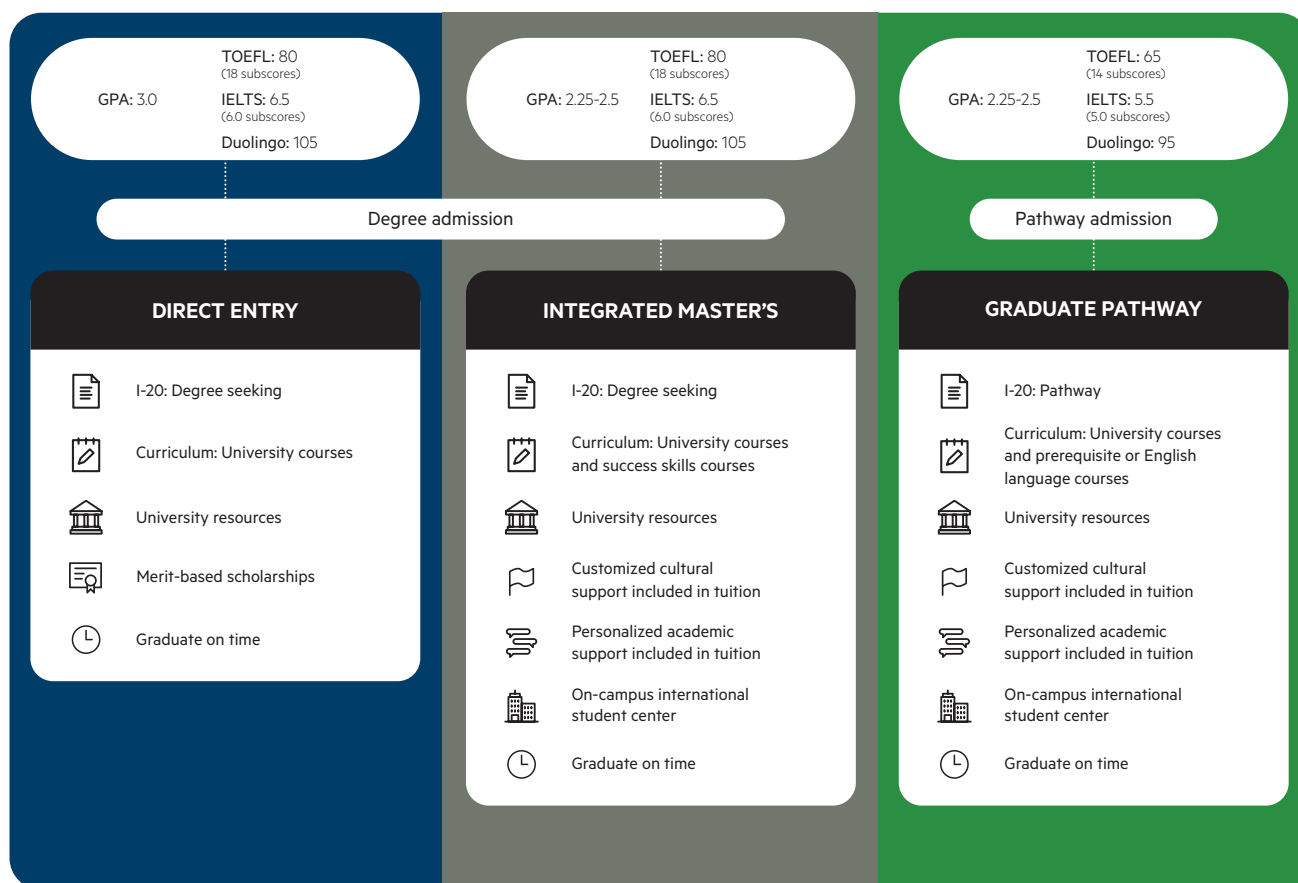
How will I be admitted?

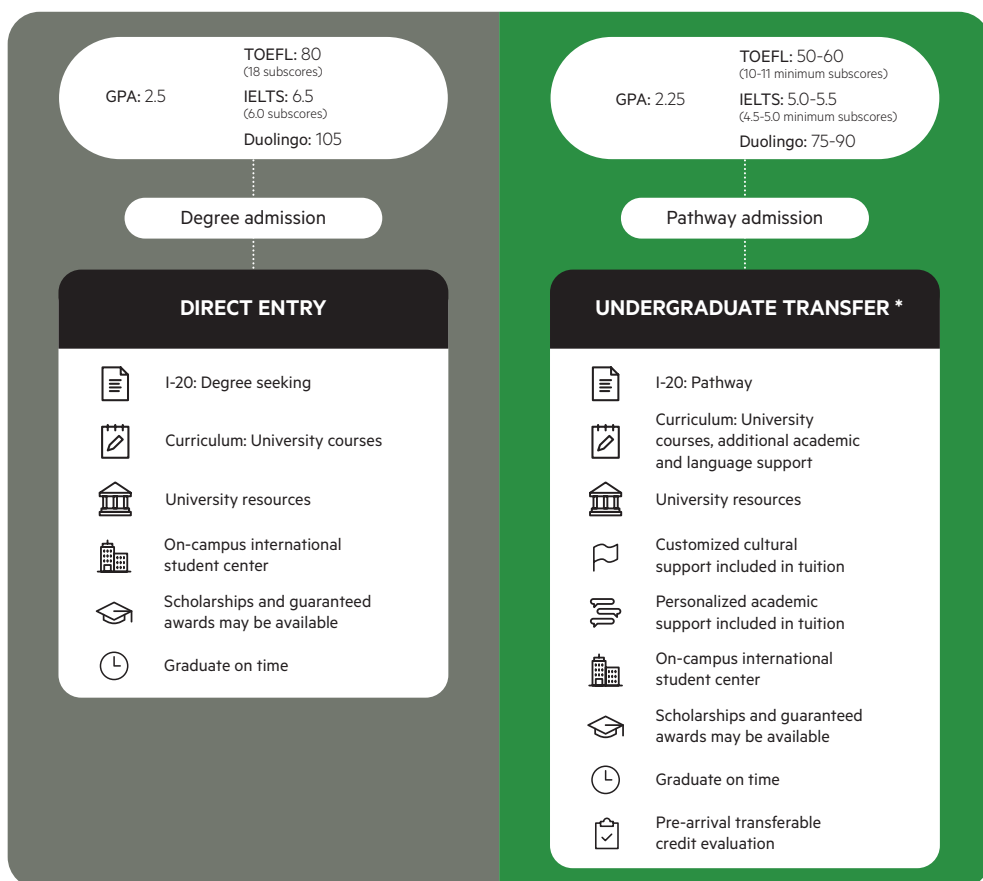
