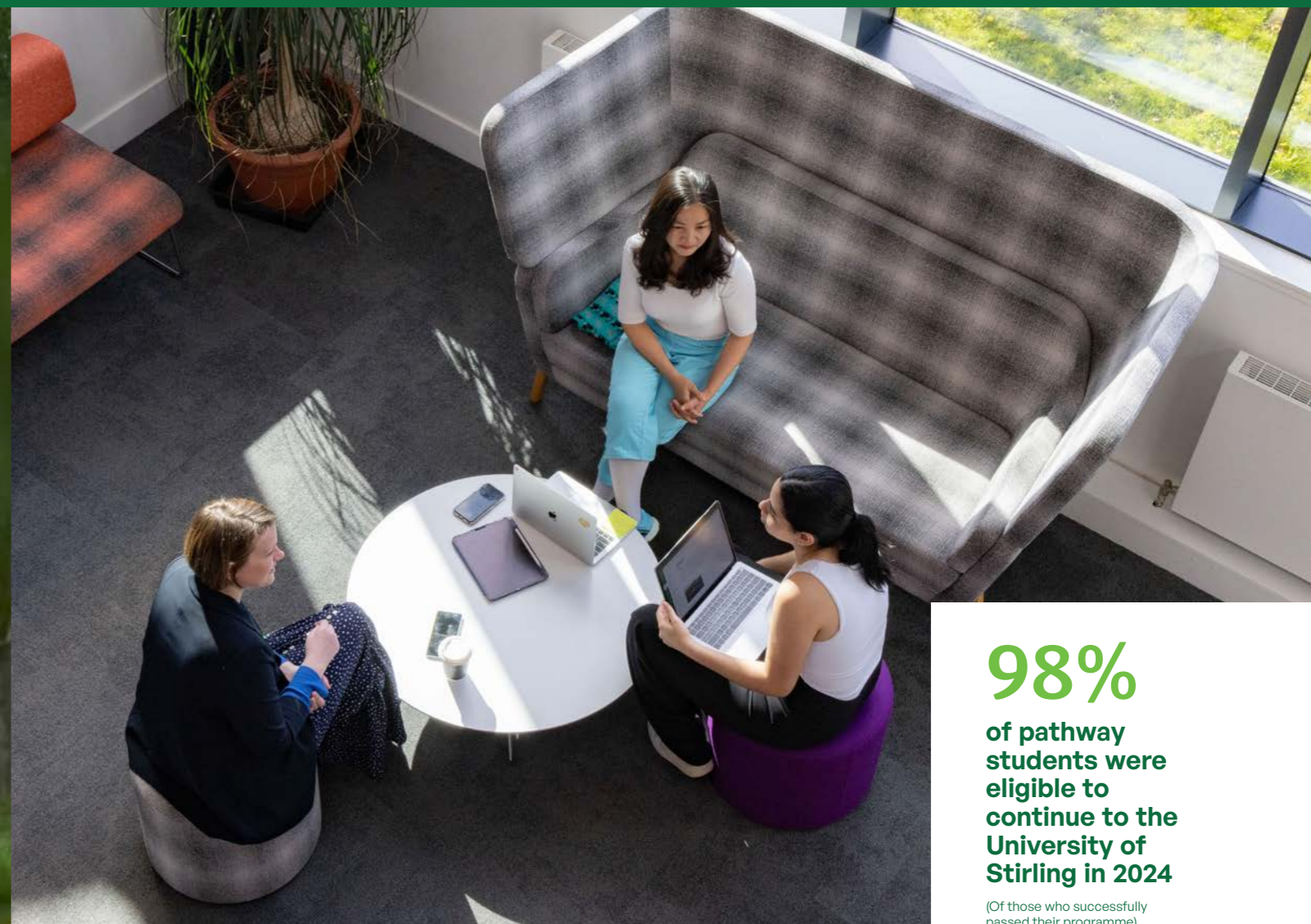

English language courses

Academic English

- Increase your IELTS score by up to 1 band per term.
- Learn the academic vocabulary you'll need for your degree.
- Develop study skills such as debating, interpreting, presenting and essay writing.

Pre-sessional English

- English language and study skills for University of Stirling offer holders.
- Improve your IELTS score by 0.5-1.0 points depending on your study length.
- Online and on-campus courses available.

Combine your degree and pathway programme

Our iCAS – integrated Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) – programmes make studying abroad simple. Your pathway and degree are combined in a single study plan – and you’ll only need one visa.

Why choose iCAS?

- One visa for the full length of your study plan, with no requirement to return home between programmes.
- Improve your subject knowledge, English language and academic skills in preparation for your degree.
- Enhanced course content, including work experience placements for Pre-Master’s students.
- Apply with a range of English language qualifications, not just IELTS.
- Regular start dates and flexible study lengths to suit different English language levels.
