- Main address:** 219 Beacon Street, Boston, MA 02116
- Location:** Nestled between shops, cafes and some of Boston's most celebrated attractions, including Fenway Park, Boston Public Library and the Charles River Esplanade.
Average 25 minutes by foot or 20 minutes by public transportation to/from TALK Boston.
- Room details:** Single or shared by 2 to 5 students. Fully furnished with an en-suite bathroom. Includes a bed, a dresser, a desk and a chair for each student. A closet, microwave, mini fridge and air conditioner.
- Meals:** Buffet-style breakfast & dinner (*except July 4th – brunch only.*)

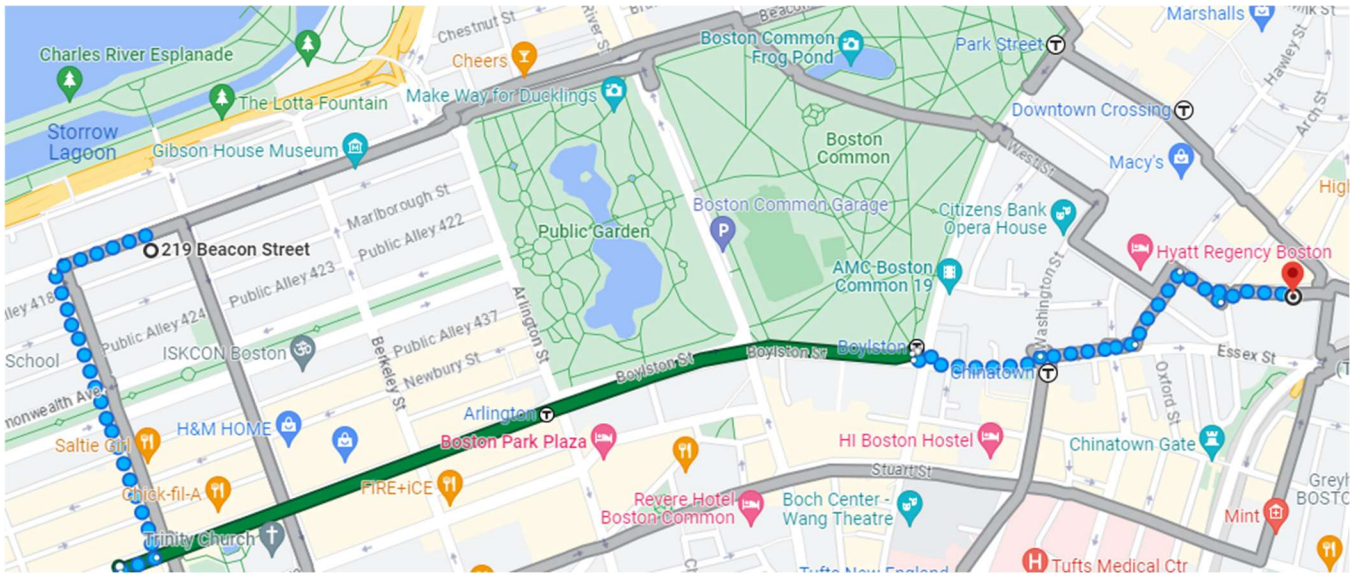

Public Transportation: The international Guest House is situated close to Boston Public Library and Copley Square subway station. It takes about 20 minutes by subway to get to TALK Boston.
